

NextQuestion Privacy Policy

Golden Voice Technologies, Inc. (“NextQuestion,” “we,” “our,” and/or “us”) values the privacy of individuals who use our NextQuestion mobile application, website (www.nextquestion.co) and related services (collectively, our “Services”). This privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”) explains how we collect, use, and share information from users of our Services (“Users”). By using our Services, you agree to the collection, use, disclosure, and procedures this Privacy Policy describes. Beyond the Privacy Policy, your use of our Services is also subject to our Terms of Service (<https://www.nextquestion.co/termservice>).

Information We Collect

We may collect a variety of information from or about you or your devices from various sources, as described below.

A. Information You Provide to Us.

Registration and Profile Information. If you sign up for an account, register to use our Services, or sign up for notifications or updates, we ask you for your name, username, phone number, and a profile photo.

Communications. If you contact us directly, we may receive additional information about you. For example, when you contact us for customer support, we will receive your name, phone number, the contents of a message or attachments that you may send to us, and other information you choose to provide.

Careers. If you decide that you wish to apply for a job with us, you may submit your contact information and your resume online. We will collect the information you choose to provide on your resume, such as your education and employment experience.

B. Information We Collect When You Use Our Services.

Device Information. We receive information about the device and software you use to access our Services, including IP address (which may tell us your general location), web browser type, operating system version, phone carrier and manufacturer, application installations, device identifiers, mobile advertising identifiers, and push notification tokens.

Your Questions, Answers, and Usage Information. We receive the questions and audio answers that you post to our Services. To help us understand how you use our Services and to help us improve them, we also automatically receive information about your other interactions with our Services, like the pages or other content you view, the searches you conduct, people you follow, any other content you post, and the dates and

times of your visits.

Your Contacts. If you permit us to access the address book on your device, we will access and store names and contact information from your address book, and keep them updated, to facilitate invitations and social interactions that you initiate through our Services and for other purposes described in this privacy policy or at the time of consent or collection. We also collect your contacts if you invite them to use our Services or share information or content with them from our Services. You may access your device's operating system settings to learn about options for enabling or disabling the sharing of your contacts information.

Information from Cookies and Similar Technologies. We and our third party partners collect information using cookies, pixel tags, or similar technologies. Our third party partners, such as analytics and advertising partners, may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across different services. Cookies are small text files containing a string of alphanumeric characters. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies. A session cookie disappears after you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser and may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to our Services.

How We Use the Information We Collect

We use the information we collect:

- To communicate with you, provide you with updates and other information relating to our Services, provide information that you request, respond to comments and questions, and otherwise provide customer support;
- For marketing purposes, such as developing and providing promotional materials that may be relevant, valuable or otherwise of interest to you;
- To send you text messages and push notifications;
- To find and prevent fraud, and respond to trust and safety issues that may arise;
- For compliance purposes, including enforcing our Terms of Service or other legal rights, or as may be required by applicable laws and regulations or requested by any judicial process or governmental agency; and
- For other purposes for which we provide specific notice at the time the information is collected.

The use of your information following any of these events will be governed by the provisions of this Privacy Policy in effect at the time the applicable information was collected.

Consent. We may also disclose your information with your permission.

Third Parties

Security

We make reasonable efforts to protect your information by using physical and electronic safeguards designed to improve the security of the information we maintain. However, as no electronic transmission or storage of information can be entirely secure, we can make no guarantees as to the security or privacy of your information.

Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect, maintain, or use personal information from children under 13 years of age, and no part of our Services is directed to children. International Visitors

Our Services are hosted in the United States and intended for visitors located within the United States.
